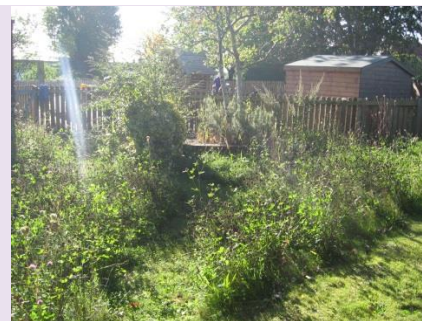
Living Eggs

We have our own sun caps which children wear outside on sunny days.
