30 hour places

If you are accessing a 30 hour place, please remember to reconfirm your eligibilty every 3 months from the date you applied. You will get a text/email 4 weeks before your reconfirmation deadline. This will ask you to log into your account and it is a quick process. You do not need to bring your code into nursery again. If you miss the deadline you will need to reapply and this is a longer process.

We have some spare 30 hour places for the January term. If you think you may be eligible and you are currently accessing a 15 hour place please ask in the office for further details about how to apply.

Harvest Food Collection

We are collecting items for the Durham Foodbank. We are collecting items including powdered milk, sugar, fruit juice, pasta, tinned food, jam, biscuits, instant (kettle) meals, tea, coffee and men's toiletries.

Items can be brought into nursery from Monday 7^{th} October until Friday 18^{th} October.
