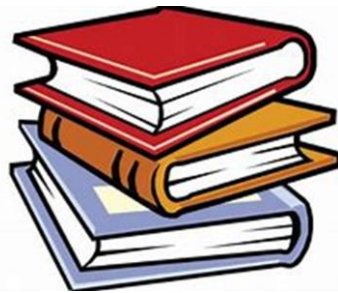
Names on shoes
