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Tips for Saying Goodbye

It is very common for children under the age of five to find separating from you difficult – even when they enjoy nursery. The following tips may help to make that goodbye easier:

1. Create a goodbye ritual such as a high five, or a special place to wave.
2. Stick to a routine each morning/afternoon.
3. Send positive signals- look happy and confident as you leave- your child will take a lead from you.
4. If you think your child may be upset, you can leave a comfort blanket/toy for them.



Tidying Up

We are encouraging the children to work together to tidy up the nursery at the end of each session – and some are more enthusiastic than others! We hope they will also help tidy up their toys at home too. Tidying up provides valuable opportunities to talk about objects and group them together.

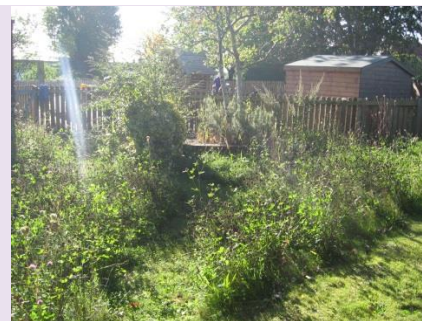
Payments for lunch/childcare
