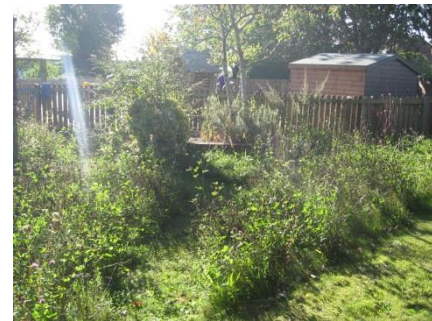

## Dates
