## Nursery Ted

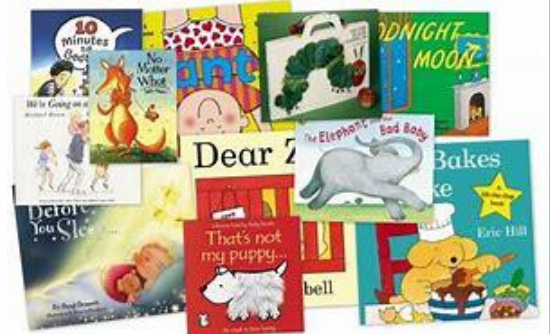
