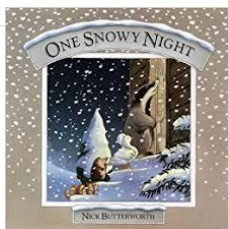
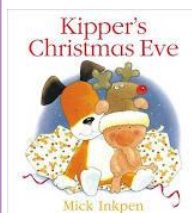
Scholastic Book Club

Easy Peasy App for Parents

Our nursery has been asked to join a research study for **Easy Peasy**, which is a smartphone app for parents of pre-school children. It is designed to improve early child development through increasing positive parent-child interactions and learning at home. The app sends regular game ideas to parents that they can play with their children (away from the phone), combined with information about child development.
